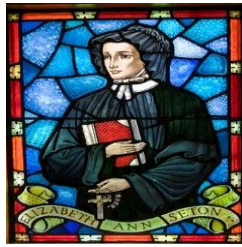


Three Kings Day Celebration

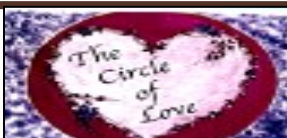
