At this time, masks are mandated for all participants in liturgies held in Catholic churches spaces located in the Diocese of Buffalo regardless of vaccination status.

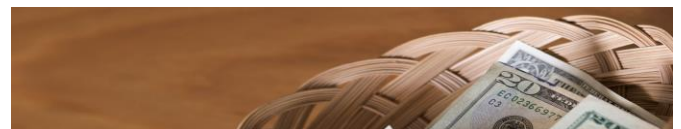
Martin Luther King Jr Day

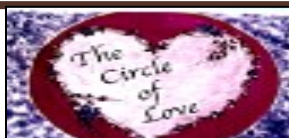
