**Scholarships and NCCS families**

The BISON Children's Scholarship Fund is accepting pre-applications for funding for the 2020-2021 school year now for families new to NCCS and the Bison funding. Families with students entering into Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade at a Catholic School in 2020-2021 should apply online through the Bison website at <http://bisonfund.com/our-scholarships> Pre-application will only be available electronically again this year and only takes a few minutes to complete. The deadline to apply for 2020-2021 is February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Families currently receiving Bison Funding will be notified by email when it is time to start the recertification process so watch your email.

Average scholarships are \$1,445 with a maximum of \$2,100. At present over 1900 children in 81 different private schools receive such a grant. Each family is required to contribute something toward their child's private education.

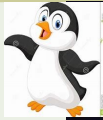
