- <u>Days of Abstinence</u> (No meat) –Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent including Good Friday. Applies to all who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- Days of Fast One full meal and perhaps two minimal meals (all without meat) for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This is for all who have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and are not yet 60 years old.

<u>Self-denial</u> – is encouraged voluntarily. Acts might include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten devotions, the Rosary, deeds of kindness etc.
