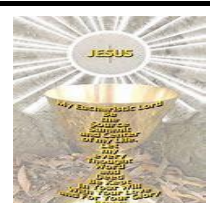
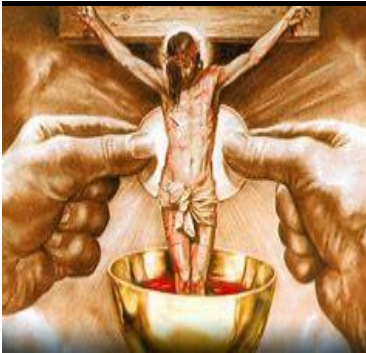

Second Collection This Week

Annually the Diocese of Buffalo asks our support for the Catholic Communication Campaign so that we can communicate the Gospel through Catholic social media activities especially podcasts, TV, radio and print media. Half of all proceeds remain in our diocese to support our local needs. This includes the *Western New York Catholic*, *Daybreak TV Productions* and diocesan radio productions. Please be as generous as possible

On behalf of Fr. Walter and myself, welcome back to our first public Mass since the middle of March. It has certainly been a long time since we celebrated and joined together as the Body of Christ. It is, therefore, fitting we celebrate this weekend the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ.

I have to admit that I am a bit nervous as to how things will go this weekend. As you know, we still have many restrictions on us, and I hope you help us by doing all that you can to follow the guidelines that are in place – **I would hate to see a spike in the virus that would force us to shut down the church again.** As a reminder, here are some things that you can help me with:

1. Please wear a suitable face mask that covers your nose and mouth while in the church. The church has purchased a few masks in case you do not have one. If you are in need, please ask one of the ushers.
2. Please do not remove the yellow caution tape from any of the pews. The pews are cordoned off to accommodate the six (6) foot distancing requirements
3. Families and others who live in the same household may sit together in the same pew. All others should separate and sit in a different area.
4. At the Sign of Peace, please greet the people next to you with a simple "Peace be with you!" We are asked not to shake hands or share a kiss.
5. Everyone down the center aisle with four (4) communion stations in front of the sanctuary steps. Again, please try to maintain a six-foot distance during the communion processions.
6. If you are not able to walk down the aisle, please let an usher know, and one of the ministers will bring you communion after everyone has received communion.
7. The Body of Christ will be distributed in hand only. This procedure is for your protection and the protection of the ministers.
8. Father and Deacon will not greet people at the doors before the start of Mass or after Mass. Although it is hard for us to keep a distance from you, it is not prudent (especially for Father Walter) to greet you at this time.

At this time, Camp Turner continues to function as it has, and we expect to operate our full summer camping program. However, in the near future there will be discussions on how the camp may continue without diocesan support. Once the virus situation is under control we will bring interested stakeholders together to share ideas about the future.

May I ask for your help? In order to ensure that we are in a position to become independent this fall, we need to have a robust summer. There are three ways you can help:

- 1) Because faith formation classes are interrupted, and Catholic Schools are temporarily closed, I am looking for ways to **get summer camp brochures into the hands of potential families**. - 3) **Please refer potential staff!** I still have 10 staff positions to fill. I need 4 males and 4 females, at least 18 years of age, to be cabin counselors. Skills in camping, outdoor living, nature study, team building, games, sports, lifeguarding, fishing, orienteering, drama, dance and cheer are all appreciated. Candidates must be compassionate, empathetic people, with a heart for serving others. It's really helpful if they are good Catholics too. I also need a couple of support staff – age 17 and up – to be activity assistants.

Thank you for your support. Although we are deeply saddened by the loss of so many diocesan ministries and the departure of so many good friends, we are very grateful to be able to continue serving the good people of this diocese.

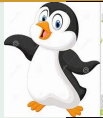

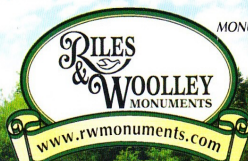
