Collaborative Model Consortium

Inaugural Collaborative Model Consortium Held Here in Buffalo

As of May 4, 2022, 130 dioceses of the 192 in the United States have been contacted so far by our Renewal Team to inquire whether or not they are in a collaborative model. Of the 130 dioceses contacted, we spoke with 96 – a 50% sample size.

Of the 96 dioceses we have spoken with:

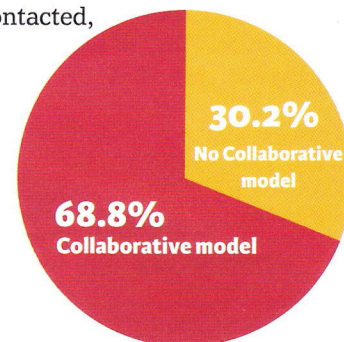
- 66 Dioceses have already converted to a collaborative model of ministry (Family of Parishes).
- 29 Dioceses have no collaborative model in place as of yet.

Of the 66 dioceses already in a collaborative model:

- 29 have over 10 years of experience with this model. (44%)
- 11 have 5 – 10 years of experience with this model. (17%)
- 6 are in their first year of working with this model. (9%)

The above data clearly indicates that the Diocese of Buffalo is not alone when it comes to responding to the changing times by adopting a collaborative model solution. We are in good company and have taken on the role of designing what will become a Collaborative Model Consortium of US Dioceses.

The five core member dioceses first gathered at Canisius College on May 18-20, 2022 to identify:



Historical factors that motivated their change

Common obstacles and struggles prior to and post collaborative model

Procedural and social dynamics

Early metrics indicating success and need for more improvement

The results of this initial meeting will be presented at a larger gathering tentatively scheduled for sometime **this Fall**.

Ultimately, the vision is to establish a consortium which would include as many dioceses as possible to proactively and collaboratively understand and address the obstacles we face in growing the Catholic Church once again.



Six Pillars of Church Life

An Update on Pilot Families

As our Pilot Program parishes began working to become Families of Parishes, Transition Teams were formed to work out the details. We quickly learned that a better and more efficient method of discussing, deciding and reforming the numerous activities that fall under each of these six Pillars with a Family vision in mind was needed. At this point, Pillar Groups were formed. Pillar Groups are teams of experts dedicated to working collaboratively to construct, monitor and evaluate the goals of the six Pillars that will lay the foundation for the Family Action Plan.

The Family Action Plan is a strategic plan for the Family that defines goals, strategies, expected outcomes and methodology for reaching a vibrant future with vitality and fiscal responsibility.
