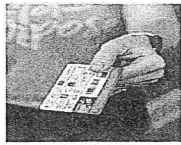


### Monthly Rosary

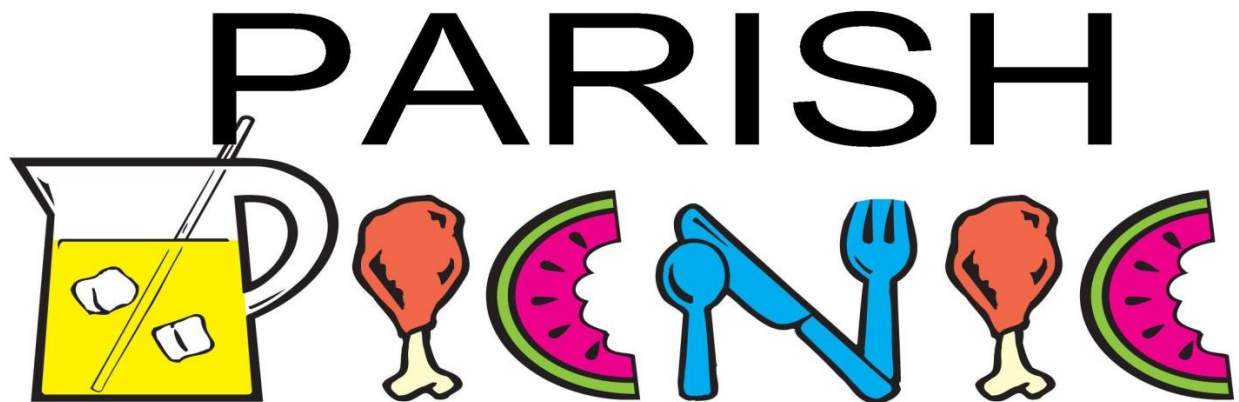
