**The Cross at the Crossroads**

In Scotland in the 1930s, a minister named George MacLeod founded the Iona Community, a group of committed ministers and church members. Ever since, the Iona Community has called the Church of Scotland back to peace and justice — and serving presence — in the world. In a famous sermon, George MacLeod spoke of the need to return the cross to the center of the town: that "the Cross be raised again at the center of the market-place as well as on the steeple of the church." He said: *I am recovering the claim that Jesus was not crucified in a cathedral between two candles, but on a cross between two thieves; on the town garbage heap; at a crossroad so cosmopolitan they had to write his title in Hebrew and in Latin and in Greek (or shall we say in English, in Bantu and in Afrikaans?); at the kind of place where cynics talk smut, and thieves curse, and soldiers gamble. Because that is where he died. And that is what he died about. And that is where church people should be and what church membership should be all about*
