### A Message From Fr Mark

Dear Friends,

Thanks so much to each of you for your kind welcome to me last week. I'm happy and honored to be a part of our Parish community at St. Elizabeth Ann's.

I mentioned at one of the Masses last weekend that I say a few prayers after every Mass I celebrate. The act of praying after Mass has a long history in our Church. Such prayers are typically offered in thanksgiving to God for the gift of the Mass, plus any final intentions or intercessions a person wishes to make before heading back in to the mission fields of our home, community, and world.

Over the last few years I developed the practice of praying after each Mass. I typically offer an Act of Faith, and Act of Hope, and an Act of Love – or – three Hail Mary's for an increase in faith, hope and love.

I also then add the following prayer:

O St. Joseph, who listened to the voice of an Angel in a dream and took Mary as your wife, invite me into the mystery of your Holy Family. And grant that I may there dwell there always — with you, Mary and Jesus — in time and in eternity, on earth and in heaven.

And grant that all my nieces, nephews, godchildren and godparents, and all of their family members; and all of my parishioners – past, present, and future – and all of their family members, may do the same. Amen

I started offering that prayer because I realized I wasn't praying enough for my godchildren ... and it just grew from there. You've all been in my daily prayers these last few years. And of course, will continue to be! Prayer changes things. And it changes things in ways we often do not see or imagine. Let's keep praying – and remain united in the love the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.


