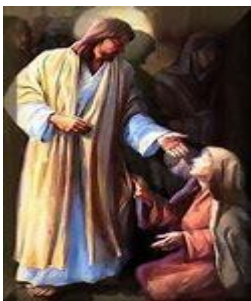
Upon reaching their 19th birthday should assume their own identity by registering with the parish.

Payments for Upon This Rock go directly to the Foundation of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Buffalo and NOT to the Diocese of Buffalo. Therefore, all pledge payments cannot be used for settlements or legal fees associated with the sex abuse cases.

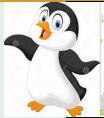
