A Message From Fr Mark

Dear Friends,

Thank you all so much for coming to Mass this weekend. Years ago, while serving for a year at the Catholic Mission of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in the town of Benque Viejo del Carmen in Belize, I led a youth retreat with a group of other young adults and teachers from our Catholic High School there. One of the young women who was part of the retreat team opened the retreat with a prayer that I found so profound. After I heard her recite it from memory I asked her if she had written it. She let me know that it was actually written by Blessed Elizabeth of Trinity, who had been a French Carmelite in the early 1900s.

The prayer is included in the Catechism of the Catholic Church – which is an amazing book and summary of our faith in its own right. Here is the great prayer of Blessed Elizabeth of the Trinity:

O my God, Trinity whom I adore, help me forget myself entirely so to establish myself in you, unmovable and peaceful as if my soul were already in eternity. May nothing be able to trouble my peace or make me leave you, O my unchanging God, but may each minute bring me more deeply into your mystery! Grant my soul peace. Make it your heaven, your beloved dwelling and the place of your rest. May I never abandon you there, but may I be there, whole and entire, completely vigilant in my faith, entirely adoring, and wholly given over to your creative action. Amen.
