Remembering Us In Your Will

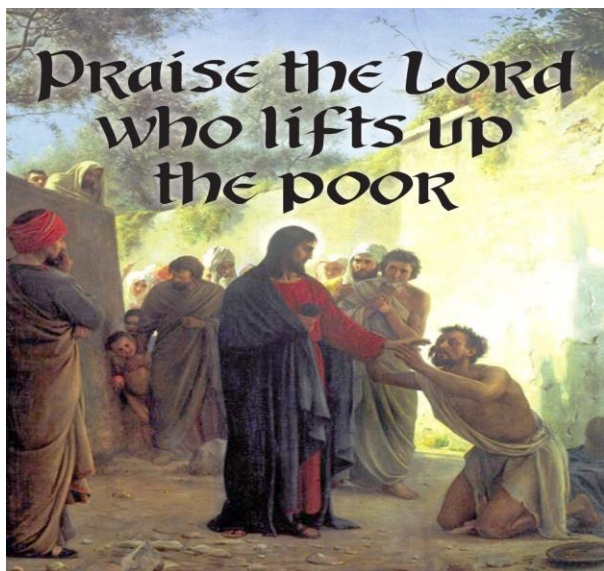

Gospel Mk 9:30-37

CHALLENGE

Amid these challenging times with parish revenue declining since covid closures many capital repairs were forced to be put on hold. In the midst of this decline a fellow parishioner is offering to donate to the parish \$10,000—his yearly required minimum IRA distribution. How wonderful if this amount could be matched in full or in part by similar donations! So is the challenge: **Can you help us reach \$50,000 for capital repairs?** We already have an anonymous donation of \$10,000, if others can contribute any amount to achieve the balance of \$40,000 for the following capital repairs:

1. Sealing and striping of the parking lots and driveway.
2. The fixing of the sidewalk pavement in front of the church.
3. The heating system.
4. Church lighting.
