Pastor's Column

Change...

Does anyone like change? I know I don't! I love to be comfortable doing what I have always done and knowing what to expect. But it seems that in our world today that we are bombarded with constant change. Change for the good and change for the worse. Changes that if my grandparents, who are now deceased, heard what was happening they would have thought that the world has gone mad. Until more recently our stability has been the Catholic Church. We have our pew, we know the people that sit around us, and we are familiar with the music and the length of the mass. Then comes the Road to Renewal... and our stable place has been turned upside down. Our mass times have changed, we are getting visiting priests saying mass, different people singing, and someone else is sitting in our pew!

I know this change is hard, and today you see another change, a combined bulletin. But the reason for this change is to thrive as a church and not just survive. A priest a couple of months ago shared with me his thoughts on the future church. He stated that the average death of a male is 78 and a female is 82. He asked me to go to my church and look around to see how many people at the mass will be alive with this statistic in ten, fifteen, and twenty years? It's sad to say but we have some masses in our family where there might be one or two people left at that mass. With the rise in cost of gas, electric, groceries etc., and decrease in population in our area, we have to find a way to combine services and people, to save as much money as we can. Please know that if these changes were not necessary for the future church, we would not be doing them. We are hurting as a church spiritually and financially. These changes will help us offer quality services but will require some help from you! As the sign says on construction sites "Please excuse our mess, under construction," please know that we are under construction and things will be messy at first but we will figure things out to be smoother than ever.

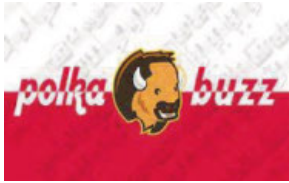

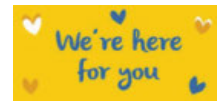
