

Pastor's Message

Godparents....

One thing in the church that I wish they would change is Godparents. This has always been a point of contention as many parents ask people to be their child's godparent without knowing what is required of them. I have had people approach me and say "Father why can't my friend be the godparent?" And I had to tell them "because they are an atheist, how are they supposed to teach them about God when they do not believe in God themselves?" I know this sounds rough, but I have had people choose godparents who were practicing witchcraft! There have also been a lot of good people in the community and have very good hearts but do not practice their faith and therefore do not qualify to be a godparent.

According to the catechism of the church 1255: "the role of the godfather and godmother, who must be firm believers, (and is to be) able and ready to help the newly baptized child or adult on the road to Christian life." In order to be a godparent, the godparent must be fully initiated members of the Catholic Church who are at least 16 years of age. A fully initiated person is someone who has received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist and who continues to witness to the faith in everyday living. What is tough about godparents is that some priests let anyone and everyone be a godparent, and some are so strict that the Pope himself would not qualify.

In the early church, the role of a sponsor was very necessary. When our faith was just beginning, it was illegal to be a Christian, and if you were caught you and your family could be fed to wild animals. The sponsor would evaluate the person who wanted to be Christian and would teach them privately until they truly believed that they were not going to be in danger. If the person turned on the group, the family and friends and everyone in that Christian community could be subjected to death, so it was important that they were vetted properly as it was truly life or death. Parents have come stating that they do not know anyone who would qualify as a godparent (someone who goes to Mass on weekends and holy days, and goes to confession at least once a year). I may be asking if there are parishioners who may be willing to stand in as godparents, and get to know the family and be available to help the child and the parents when teaching the faith. Most of the time it is already too late when I find out that the parents already asked someone to be a godparent, so this is where I need your help. Please consider talking to your children and family about this so it is not a surprise if someone does not qualify. I hate to lose someone to our faith because they picked a godparent who does not meet the requirements.


