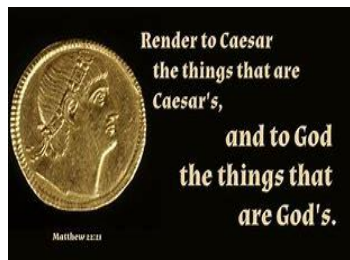
Upon reaching their 19th birthday should assume their own identity by registering with the parish.

Jesus Helps Us to See God

There's a story about some older men who gathered to celebrate the 50th anniversary of their college graduation. Naturally, all of them had changed in appearance over the years – they were grayer, heavier, balder, more wrinkled and so on. The Church does not allow scattering cremated remains, dividing cremated remains or keeping them in the home for a long time.
