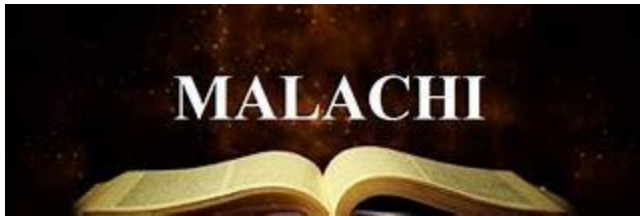

**All Saint Day**

One could say that this is a Feast of Perspective, of renewing our focus on what really matters, and of realizing that our human way of thinking is not God's way. The eschatological perspective provided by the Book of Revelation in the first reading, the words of John in the second reading showing us the essence of holiness, and the lesson of the Beatitudes that keeps reminding us how we usually get things upside-down, all contribute to this perspective. And it is not just a matter of how we see things, but of where our passion is, as the Psalm makes clear. We are the people that longs to see God's face. That's the driving force behind our worship, our daily activities, and the manner in which we handle our daily trails.

The saints lived the Beatitudes. They sought righteousness in their own relationships and they sought to bring righteousness into the world. They fought for the Kingdom of God in the civil arena-see how St. John the Baptist and St. Thomas More gave their lives.

So we through elections, have the opportunity to shape the world according to God's Kingdom, starting with the defense of our fundamental rights (life first) and the freedom of the Church. We reject candidates and parties who reject those rights.
