Remembering Us In Your Will

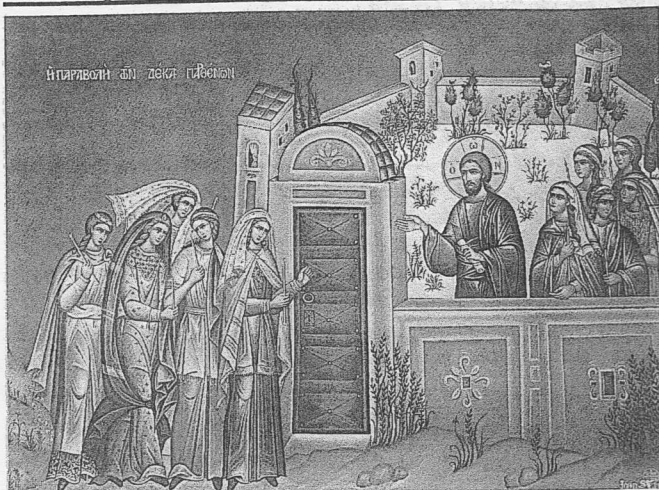

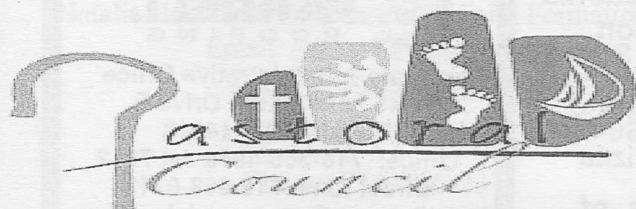

FAITH IN THE FAMILY

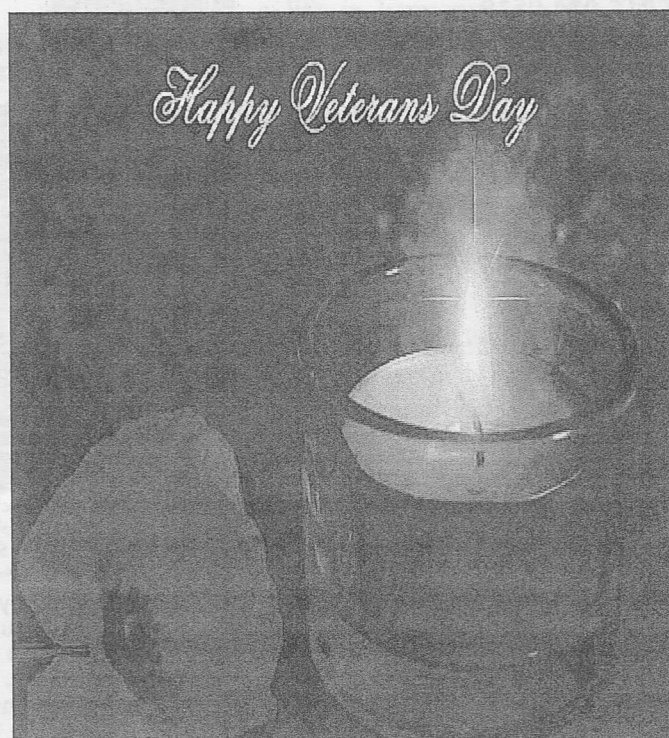

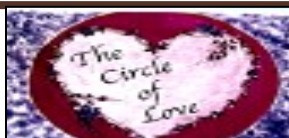
