Pastor's Message



Our family lived modestly on Buffalo's far east side, about six blocks from Cheektowaga, where our parish was. My sister Mary, became a Sister of Mercy, my sister Therese, married a guy who teaches

Additional at Franciscan University in Steubenville, OH, and I became a monk for thirty years and a priest for the Diocese of Buffalo.

İ got piano lessons as soon as it was feasible. In first grade, we started reading English in September, and I started reading music at piano lessons in October. After a few years, I abandoned my career plans of becoming a bus driver and thought about being a musician instead. I worked my way through music school both as a church organist and playing in a piano bar in a swanky restaurant. In 1979, I received an MFA in music from UB. In 1981, I pursued a monastic vocation at Mount Angel Abbey in Oregon.

In 1996, I was permitted to finish a Master of Divinity degree in preparation for priestly ordination in 1998. My mother passed away in 2001, and my dad, had congestive heart failure had just turned 90, needed help with his care. In 2002, returned to Buffalo to be my dad's caregiver and began working in parishes on weekends.

After my dad's passing in 2006, I sought and was granted permission to work in the Buffalo Diocese while still a monk. I was pastor of St. Dominic serving Brocton, Westfield and Ripley from 2007 until 2016. In 2012, the Holy Father granted me permission to be dispensed from monastic vows and to incardinate as a priest for the Diocese of Buffalo. I came to Fredonia to be pastor of both St. Joseph and St. Anthony Parishes in 2016.

Fun fact! I think my patron saints are watching out for me. My confirmation name is Dominic, and Joseph and Anthony are my two baptismal names. Devotedly in the Lord, Fr. Joe Walter
