# Pastor's Message

### Deacon Mike Lemieux

Born and raised in the heart of the Adirondacks, Deacon Mike came to Chautauqua County in 1974 to attend SUNY Fredonia. After

completing a Baccalaureate degree Psychology, Deacon enrolled at the University of Buffalo, earning a Master's degree in Counseling and Student Affairs Administration. Deacon Mike spent his career SUNY professional at Fredonia working in Residence Life and Career Development and 28 years as the Director of Campus Life and the Williams Center (Student Union). Before retiring after 40 years in 2019, Deacon served as the Dean of Students with supervision for Campus Life, Judicial Affairs, Residence Life, Student Association, and Volunteer and Community Services.

After deacon formation and completing a certificate in Pastoral Ministries, Deacon was ordained in 2001 by Bishop Mansell. Deacon taught the Liturgy Practicum to the fourthyear deacon candidates for ten years and served as a Eucharistic Minister Trainer and a member of the Deacon Council. His current Ministry of Service is at the SEAS Food Closet.


