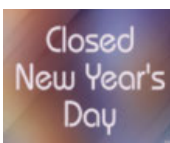

Pastor's Message**Ministry Highlight**

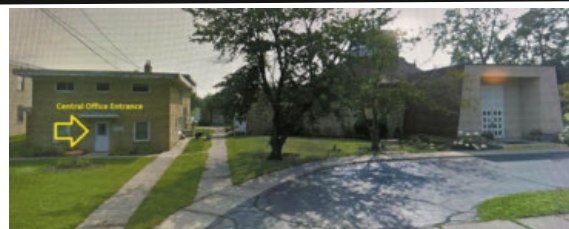

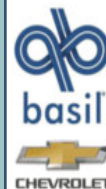
