





# Prayer for our Priests

O loving Mother Mary, Mother of Priests, take to your heart your sons who are close to you because of their priestly ordination and because of the power which they have received to carry on the work of Christ in a world which needs them so much.

Be their comfort, be their joy, be their strength, and especially help them to live and to defend the ideals of consecrated celibacy.

Our Lord Jesus, We know that You have made them priests in the likeness of your own priesthood. You have consecrated them, set them apart, anointed them, filled them with the Holy Spirit, and appointed them to teach, to preach, to minister, to console, to forgive, and to feed us with Your Body and Blood.

We thank You for choosing them from among us, so that they understand us, as we understand them, suffer with us and rejoice with us, worry with us and trust with us, as they share our lives, and our faith.

We ask that You give them this day the gift You gave Your disciples on the way to Emmaus:

Your presence in their hearts, Your holiness in their souls, Your joy in their spirits.

May they see You face to face in the breaking of the Eucharistic Bread; and may Mary our Mother, continue to stir up in them the grace of their vocation.
